Addition of NUTS 3 areas:

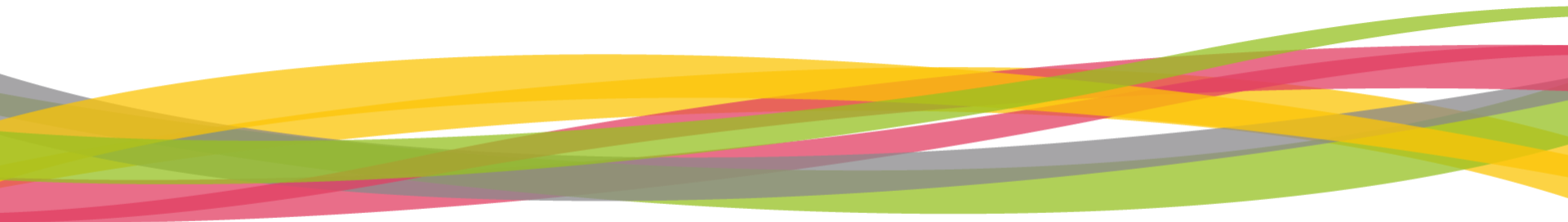
Lochaber, Skye & Lochalsh,

around the North Sea.



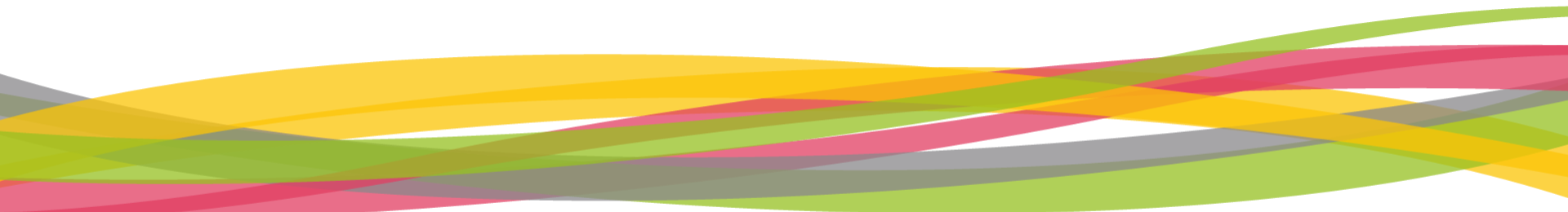
Four priorities:

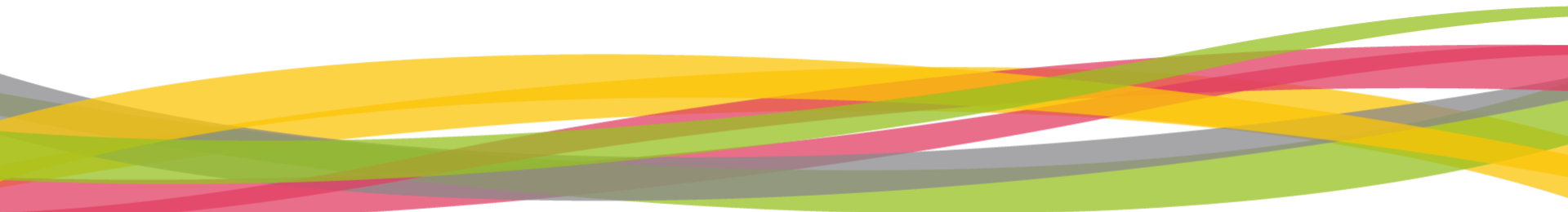

Expression of Interest (Eoi) 27 April – 30 June 2015

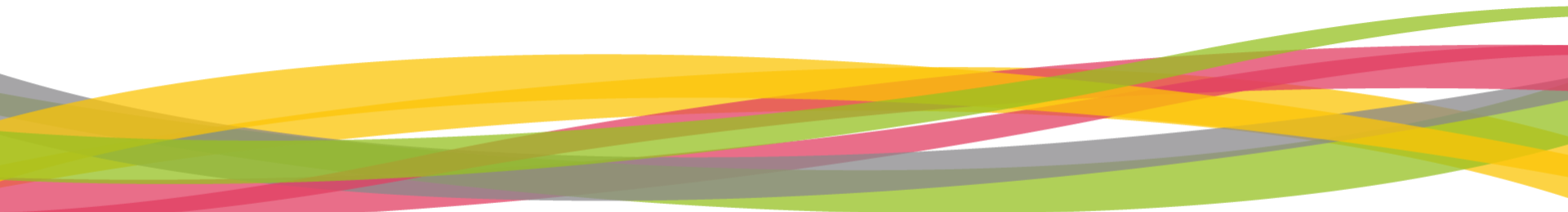
Full Application 27 April – 30 June 2015

Assessment Criteria:

Strategic: Project context, Cooperation Character, Results and Outputs, Partnership Relevance

Operational: Management, Communication, Work Plan, Budget

Grades: Very Strong, Strong, Sufficient, Insufficient
